<u>Entry Deadline:</u>	Entries must be received by 3:00PM Friday June 19, 2009 in the hands of the meet director. If you are not emailing your entries, then overnight or express mail is recommended, <i>but waive the signature</i> . It is not necessary to use overnight or express mail to send hard copy and check, which are sent in support of an e-mailed entry.
<u>Meet Format Waiver:</u>	Meet management has the right to restrict the number of entries due to darkness and adhere to the NJ Swimming/USA-Swimming 4-hour guideline rule.
<u>Internet Website Posting:</u>	Meet information, Hy-Tek Event List (HYV.file), and meet results will be posted on New Jersey Swimming website. (www.njswim.org)
<u>Meet Requirement Statement:</u>	This meet qualifies, as "one" of the two required long course meets to be eligible for the New Jersey SC Zone Championship Team or for New Jersey National Championship reimbursement.
<u>Coaches Eligibility:</u>	All coaches "on the deck" must be members of USA Swimming. Coaches must show coaching card for entrance to facility. Coaches must show coaching card before picking up any meet information or scratch sheets.
<u>Swimmer Eligibility:</u>	All swimmers must be members of USA Swimming to enter and compete in this meet. The swimmer must be listed on a team's official entry form to be eligible to participate in this swim meet in any event. Unattached Swimmers: All transfer swimmer(s) must swim unattached for 120 days from their last attached competition. Swimmers must use an UN- (New Team Alpha Code) as their team affiliation. All Unattached swimmers must be listed on the team's

	<p>official waiver entry form.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This meet will have 10 & Under, 11-12, 13-14, 15-Over Age groups events. • There are no time standards being used in this meet. • NJ Swimming only allows swimmers to compete in 3 individual events per day. • Age for this meet is: June 26, 2009
<u>Meet Format:</u>	<p>This meet will be run in accordance to current USA Swimming Rules.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This meet will be run as a time final meet. • This meet will be deck seeded with coaches checking in/scratching all swimmers. When the seeding has been posted, swimmers will report to the blocks on their own. • This meet will use the “no-recall” procedure for false starts • Fly –Over starts will be determined by the meet director after all entries are received, all teams will be notified via e-mail 72 hrs prior to the meet.
<u>Meet Schedule:</u>	Facility opens at 5:00PM. Warm-up starts at 5:00PM, Meet starts at 6:00PM

<u>Warm-up Procedures:</u>	<p>New Jersey Swimming Warm-up and Safety Guidelines:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Warm-ups will be run under New Jersey Swimming Warm-up and Safety Guidelines. Warm-ups will include general warm-up lanes, and sprint lanes. • Warm-ups will be a 50-minute general warm-up with the last 15 minutes offering Sprint lanes. • Depending on a large number of entries, the warm-up will be divided by teams into two 25-minute warm-ups with sprint lanes available in the last 10 minutes. This warm-up will be e-mailed 72 hours prior to the meet. <p>Entry Into Pool:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All swimmers must enter the pool from the starting end of the pool. • Bayonne Mermaid-Starfish meet marshals will monitor warm-ups.
<u>Check-In:</u>	<p>All check-in sheets must be turned into the scoring table 30 minutes before the start of the meet. Swimmers that are swimming will have a line through their name. Swimmers that are being scratched will have their names circled with a “SCR” next to the circle. Swimmers scratching a single event will have a line through his/her name and the event number circled with “SCR” next to the circle. Failure to follow the check-in procedure will result in the swimmer being scratched from the session</p>
<u>Starts:</u>	The host club will determine if ‘Fly-over’/‘Over-the-top’ starts will be used after a time line has been produced. This information will be sent to the participating clubs 72 hrs prior to the start of the meet.
<u>Scoring:</u>	Team Scoring will not be kept.
<u>Awards:</u>	Medals will be awarded to the top three- (3) swimmers in each event. In the Individual Medley events medals will be awarded to the top three (3) swimmers in each age group, 10 & U, 11-12 for the 12 & U IM and 13-14 and 15 & O for the 13 & O IM.
<u>Entry Fees:</u>	<p>Individual Entry Fee: \$4.00</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make checks payable to: BAYONNE MERMAIDS-STARFISH SWIM TEAM • Refunds will be given if there is a rain out of the entire meet. If the meet starts and then is called for weather, there will be no refunds

<u>Admissions and Programs:</u>	Admission – \$4.00 Cost of Program will be \$6.00.
<u>Entries:</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In accordance with NJS policy, team entries may be submitted by E-mail to mka334@optonline.net • All entries must be Hy-Tek program entries either on a 3 1/2" diskette or as an attached file to an email. • The meet entry coordinator will respond to e-mails entries within 48 hours. If you do not receive an e-mail response within 48 hours, assume that your email has not been received. It then becomes the e-mailer's responsibility to make sure that the host club's meet entry coordinator receives the e-mail. If you do not receive an e-mail response, you must contact the entry coordinator by email or phone or mail in your entries. • An Entry Summary with a signed NJ Swimming waiver and a check must accompany a mailed entry or follow an e-mailed entry. • Accuracy of seed times is essential. Incomplete entries will not be accepted. • Deck entries will not be accepted. No phone or faxed entries will be accepted. • In order to provide the most "splash" opportunities, upon receipt of entries, the host team will allow all teams 5 days to "pre-meet scratch" (reduce their entries). This "pre-meet scratch" procedure is meant to allow additional teams into the meet based upon "entered" teams being "good citizens" and adjusting their entries based upon knowledge of swimmers non-attendance post entries received by the meet host. Room created by this procedure will be filled by entries received by "closed out teams" in the order the entries were received.
<u>Results:</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All teams will be sent their results via e-mail after the meet. • Results can be ordered from the scoring table. For a cost of \$5.00
<u>Host Club Responsibilities:</u>	<p>The host club responsibilities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The host club will provide a single timer in each lane through out the meet. • The host club will have stopwatches available for volunteers helping to time. • The host club will e-mail all club entries back to the participating clubs. • The host club will create a warm-up schedule that will be fair and equal to all teams. This warm-up schedule will be e-mailed to all participating clubs no later than 72 hours before the meet. • The host club will create timing assignments that are fair and equitable with as many teams participating as possible. These timing assignments will be e-mailed to all participating clubs no later than 72 hours before the meet.
<u>Participating Club Responsibilities:</u>	<p>Participating Clubs responsibilities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participating clubs must help with timing assignments. Timing assignments will be e-mailed to participating clubs 72-hours prior to the meet. • Participating club parents must stay within designated areas away from the pool edges except for timing assignments. • Participating clubs should help with officiating whenever possible. List the club contact for club officials on the meet summary.
<u>Concessions:</u>	Food and drink will be available.
<u>Directions:</u>	NJ Turnpike Exit 14A (Bayonne) proceed along Ave. E to East 16 th St. Make a right turn proceed for 4 blocks. Pool is across the street from the firehouse and children's park.
